Protection Island Race - Addendum to PTSA Sailing Instructions

SCHEDULE – Saturday April 29 th. The Warning signal will be at 11:00 hrs on City Dock.

RULES – As in 2017 Sailing Instructions for PTSA Races except as amended herein.

<u>COURSE</u> – Cross Start line at City Dock towards the NE. Round Protection Island <u>in either direction</u>. Maintain a 200 yd. distance from the Wildlife Refuge. Cross the Finish line at City Dock towards the SW. The red Pt. Hudson bell buoy #2 is to be left to shore-ward. Course distance is 22.1 nm.

<u>CLASSES</u> – All boats will start together and race with a PHRF handicap. If three or more multi-hull boats check in for the start they will be scored as a separate class.

<u>IDENTIFICATION</u> – All boats, especially visitors, check in with the RC at the City Dock before the start to make sure their PHRF rating is recorded.

SHORTENED COURSE – There is no provision for shortening course.


TIME LIMIT – There is no time limit.

FINISH TIMES – The finish will probably be unmanned. Each boat will record the time their bow crosses the finish line, preferably to the second (use GPS or cell phone time), <u>and note the names</u> of the nearest boats ahead of, and astern of, them (if visible). This information is to be e-mailed, as soon as possible, to <u>racecommittee@ptsail.org</u>.

REQUESTS FROM USCG – All vessels must be aware of COLREGS Rule 10 (Traffic Separation (extra requirements for the race permit) – All vessels must be aware of COLREGS Rule 10 (Traffic Separation Schemes) and must comply with such regardless of their competitive position at the time.

- All vessels should monitor VHF Ch 05A.

Current 1.1 nm. NW of Point Wilson. Flood 85° True, Ebb 285° True.



Current 3.2 nm NW of Violet Point (Protection Island). Flood 120° True, Ebb 325° True.
